Starting June 10, 2024, you need to update to the new versions Productivity Tools. This update includes:

- Webex icons
- Support to scheduling a meeting in a Shared Calendar that doesn't have a host account
- User Interface refresh with removal of features that no longer function
- Advanced cohost scheduling options

HTML support for the agenda in emails sent to webinar participants

The agenda created for a webinar during scheduling is editable using html in the emails sent to the webinar participants. This provides flexibility to edit, move, or remove the agenda.

CSCvh90269	3	Webex Meetings	The Make Screen blank feature doesn't work on Windows 10 devices if User Account Control is enabled.
CSCvi72293	3	Webex Meetings (Mac)	If a user's Facebook account is locked, they can't stream Webex meetings on Facebook Live.
CSCvh63085	3	Webex Webinars (Windows)	During webinars, when a presenter shares their screen, participants can see chat notifications that appear to the presenter.
