CSCvh90269	3	Webex Meetings	The Make Screen blank feature doesn't work on Windows 10 devices if User Account Control is enabled.
CSCvi72293	3	Webex Meetings (Mac)	If a user's Facebook account is locked, they can't stream Webex meetings on Facebook Live.
CSCvh63085	3	Webex Webinars (Windows)	During webinars, when a presenter shares their screen, participants can see chat notifications that appear to the presenter.

CSCwm08689	3	Webex Meetings (Mac)	Resolved a crash issue that occurred when the avatar was not fully downloaded.

	3	Webex Meetings (Windows and Mac)	The NDI feed does not output when the TP device camera is turned off and then turned back on.
